Parent Interviews

Parent interviews will be taking place on **Wednesday 29th November** for all classes. The teachers have tried to be as flexible as possible, and the interviews will be running from 9.30am-6pm with time outs for break and lunch. We encourage all parents to attend if possible as it is an opportunity for the teacher to feed back about how your child has been getting on in class so far and to discuss any other matters.

We will be using eSchools again this year for parents to book a time slot. If your child is in Year 1 and above, then you will already of received logins for eSchools last year. Please use this when making a booking. Attached to this newsletter is a reminder on how to book a slot.

Reception children

Letters went home last week with Reception children detailing usernames and passwords to log on to eSchools. Please ensure you keep these details safe as they will be needed for all future bookings on eSchools. Please follow the 'how to' guide attached.

Please note if your child is in Reception and they have older siblings in the school, then you will not receive new login details as you will already have a login and your child will automatically be added to your account if there are siblings in the school.

We have been informed by eSchools that parents will be able to book via their mobile app this year.

If you have forgotten your login in details, then please see the office so your password can be reset.

Please note: The office will not be able to book any time slots for parents. We will only be able to reset your password for you.



Booking a Parent Interview

How to book a Parent Interview Appointment using eSchools

GO TO THE ESCHOOLS WEBSITE: www.summercourt.eschools.co.uk

1. Login using your parent login username and password.
2. Click on the parents evening button at the top of the page.
3. Follow the instructions.
4. Choose your child's name/class.
5. Choose the timeslot to meet your child's class teacher.
6. Please ensure that you only book one slot per child.
7. We recommend leaving at least 10 minutes between appointment times to allow you time to move between teachers.
8. Timeslots are limited to 10 minutes and we must keep to time. For anything you think may take longer, please arrange another appointment with your class teacher.
9. If you login and do not see your child's name OR you only see one of your children's names;
It may be that you need to ask your husband/wife/partner to login and see if they are linked to your child's profile and book through them.
