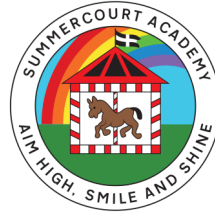


Summercourt Academy News

Staffing

If your child is ill on the day of a booked session then we will refund you the money.
