



Literacy

SPAG: Subordinating conjunctions, relative clauses, apostrophes, adverbs, parenthesis.

Place value of punctuation and grammar.

Writing units of work:

- Non-chronological report on Luminara (a fictional planet)
- Recount letter – Samuel and the anywhere arcade
- Setting description – the anywhere arcade

Science – Earth and space

- Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system
- Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth
- Describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies
- Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night, and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

Science – Evolution

- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution

Maths

- Number – place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.
- Arithmetic practice.
- Mastering number.

Other curriculum areas (ART/DT/RE/ and PE)

- ART/ DT: Improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing and painting by expressing identity in art. Research, design, make and evaluate a Roman banquet.
- Computing – Online safety and data and information (flat-file databases).
- History: The Roman Empire and its' impact on Britain – continue to develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British history.
- Geography: The Galapagos Islands - Locate the world's countries using maps; concentrate on countries' environmental regions, physical and human characteristics; describe and understand key aspects of settlement and land use and distribution of resources.
- RE: What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today? Why do Christians believe Jesus is the Mesiah?
- PSHE: JIGSAW: Being me in my world and celebrating differences.
- French: Naming and describing the planets in the solar system.
- Music: Listen and appraise classic rock music, perform a song as a group.
- PE: Invasion games. Net and wall games.
