CLASS 3

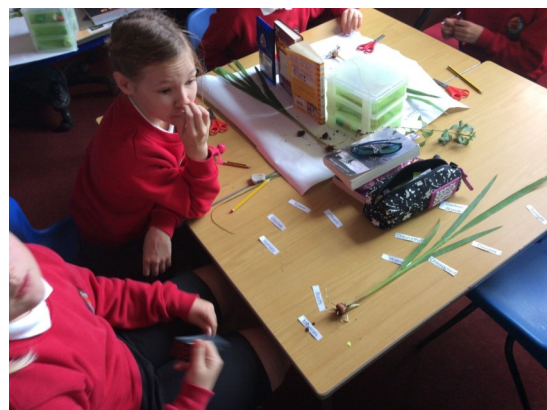


What a fantastic week of learning for Class 3! We have been immersing ourselves in the world of Clive Kings's *Stig of the Dump* and honing our inference skills.

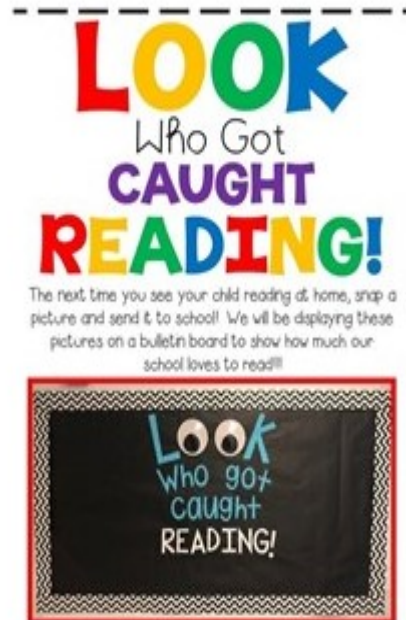
