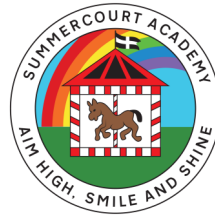

SCHOOL CENSUS DAY 3RD OCTOBER 2019

The Dept of Education School Census takes place on Thursday 3rd October 2019, with a special 'harvest' meal consisting of a pasty (steak or cheese and onion), ice cream or a cake.

Schools are funded by the Government for Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) and the number of pupils which receive a school meal on this day.

It is imperative to the school budget that as many pupils as possible in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 order a school meal on this day so that the school receives the maximum funding for meals for the forthcoming year.
