The Kingfisher Award Trip

Ennis Barton Farm

Yesterday (13/06/2019), Class 4 went to Ennis Barton Farm for the Kingfisher Award Scheme.

We left at 12:00 to set off to the farm. When we got there we rode on a tractor and trailer. We passed the sheds and the dung pile and plenty of fields. Once we got there we were put into three groups because there were three activities. Our group was Dragonflies. The first activity that we participated in was food chains/fishing, where we saw toads, frogs, newts and a stuffed otter called Ollie. Then we went to our second base where we were split into two smaller groups. The first group that we were in was a group where we found out all about how they feed the cows and their babies and how they milk the cows. We even saw some calves! The second part was how soil is made and how soil works. To make soil you need: air, moisture, organic matter and mostly sand/clay/rocks. We also found out that amazingly it takes 1000 years to make 1 cm of soil! Our last activity was again a split activity. On the first base it was a bit like food chains again except with owls. We had to pick apart regurgitated shrew/mouse bones. We even found a tooth! The next thing we did was all to do with forests. We learned how to tell how long a tree has been alive for. All you need to do is count the rings. Some for surprisingly long times, one was over 60 years. In this activity we also had to rifle through brown leaves to see if we could find any insects. After that we went to wash our hands. Overall in our opinion it was a great afternoon!
