

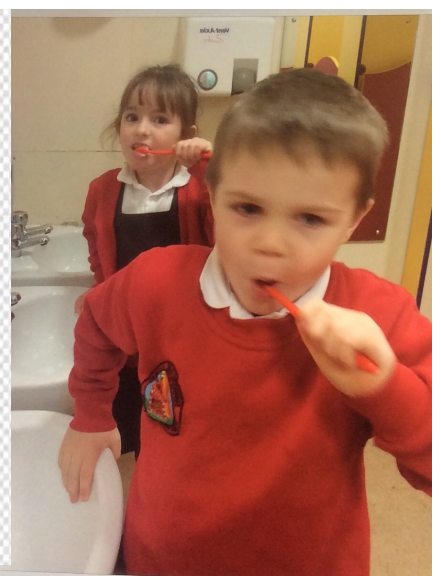

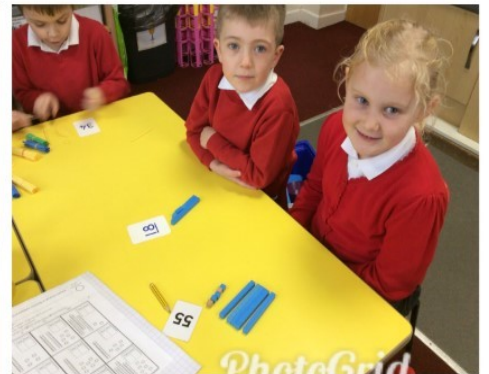
CLASS 1

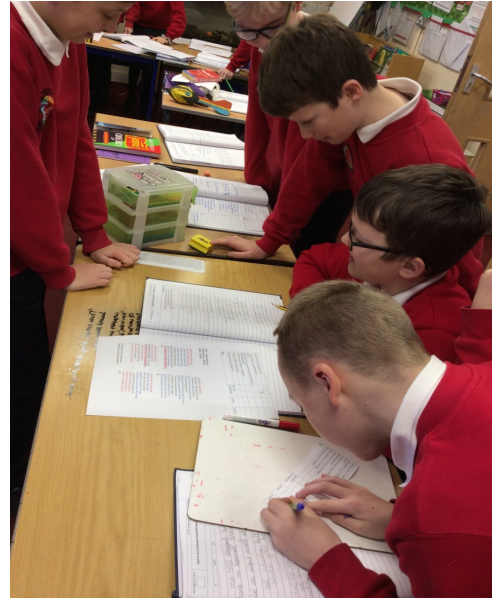
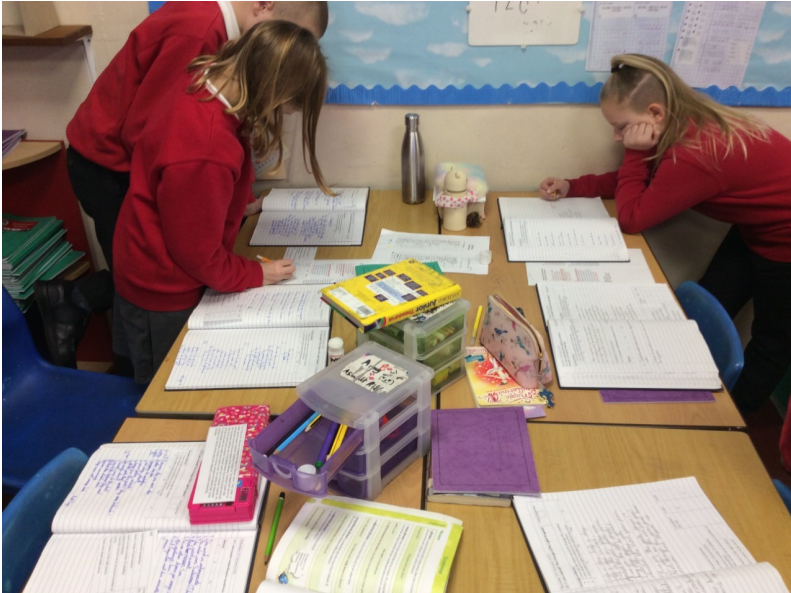
CLASS 3

FOREST SCHOOL

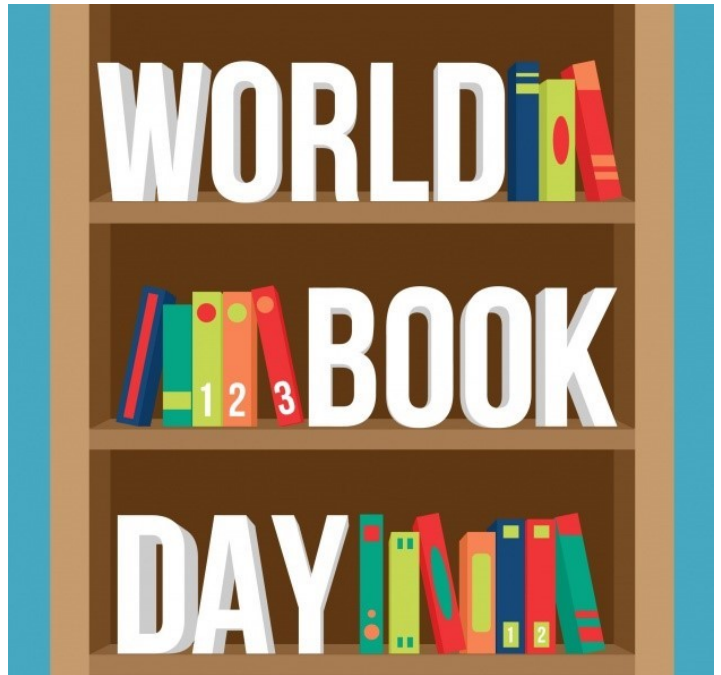
The Forest school provision has started for Class 3 and will continue until Monday 2nd March 2020.

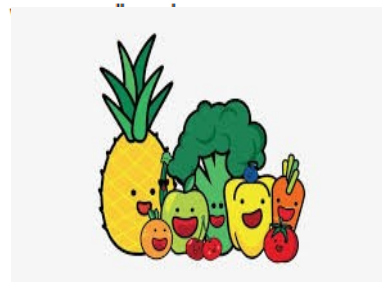
