Recently, we had an assembly on eating less sugar, and how much sugar is in different products of food. Just to make sure you are aware of your heath, please do read below.

- * The average amount of sugar a child from 4-6 should have is a maximum 5 teaspoons of sugar a day.
- * A child from 7-9 can have 6.
- * Anybody aged 11+ can have 7

We are shocked to tell you that in a single can of coke there are 10 table spoons of sugar! So please don't have too much!

Lots of you may think that fruits are a very healthy snack but grapes have 16g of sugar per 100g - some fruits are best enjoyed in moderation.

Everybody should have a handy and fun booklet to take home today all about eating smart and checking for levels of sugars in different foods.

Uniform
