Monday- INSET DAY	Monday- INSET DAY
Tuesday- Complete DERIC activity (worksheet will be posted on the day)	Tuesday- Choose 10 words from this week’s spelling list (posted as homework before the holiday). You can choose Y1, Y2 or challenging words to suit your ability. Say the words then ‘Fred talk’ the words. Which sounds are familiar to you? Write these using a pencil. Which sounds are tricky? Write these using a coloured pencil.
Wednesday- Can you find words from your reading book or from objects around the house that have the ee sound? (It can be spelt as ea or y or e or e-e)	Wednesday- Look at the spelling patterns this week. Choose 10 words that suit your ability. Look – Say – Cover – Write (remember the unfamiliar sounds) – Check Write the word again, paying extra attention to your handwriting. Remember to form all letters correctly.
Thursday- Read a book of your choice. Ask an adult or use a dictionary to check the meaning of any word that you don’t understand.	Thursday- Speed write these words. How many times can you write them in 5 minutes? Now check. How many did you spell correctly? Repeat if you get any incorrect.
Friday- Can you retell (or act out) one of the stories you have read this week. Don’t forget to give lots of details and use story language from the book. Is OK to look back at the book if you don’t remember enough details.	Friday- Ask an adult to read out the word, can you spell it correctly? If you make any mistakes, don’t worry, practice Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check again until you’ve learned it.

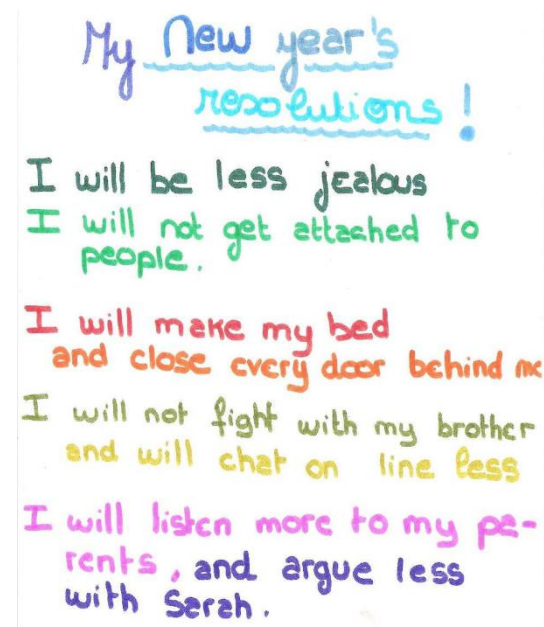
