CLASS 3

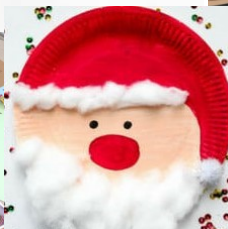

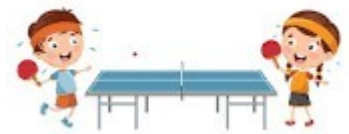
KS2 PRODUCTION

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS & ALLSORTS

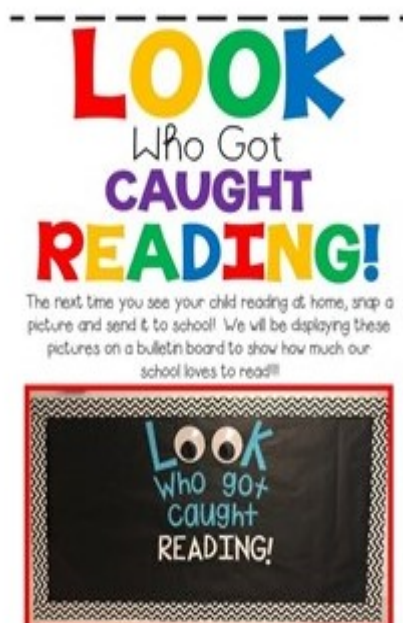
All of our after school clubs finish today and will resume after Christmas. We will notify you when we return after the holidays what date in January we will begin the clubs for the new year.
