One of our exciting changes for this year has been the implementation of a new school administration system called 'Arbor'. One of the key reasons we decided to update the school system is because the new system provides a 'Parents' Portal'

The Parents Portal allows parents and guardians to view and check information that the school holds on their child. It also provides a function to book places on clubs and select appointments for parents evening - so everything is in one easy place.

This will make it easier for you to notify us of changes, and book activities for your child.

Instructions on how to sign-up will be provided in the email that you receive from school.

We advise that you set up your account immediately so that you can check your contact details are correct. Accounts can be merged if you have more than one child in our school so you only require the one logon.

Please ask the school office for details if you have not received them.

Also, please ensure that you keep your login in and password safe as this is private to your account.

County Rugby Finals


