

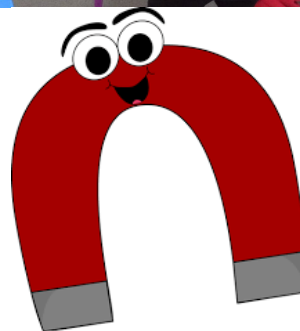

CLASS 1

This week Class 1 have been exploring the numbers 9 and 10. Making 9 and 10 using numicon, cubes and play dough. We have also been finding magnetic things.

In Maths they took turns to either use concrete resources to work out a sum of 2 digit numbers or to record the sum on paper by drawing images of tens and ones.

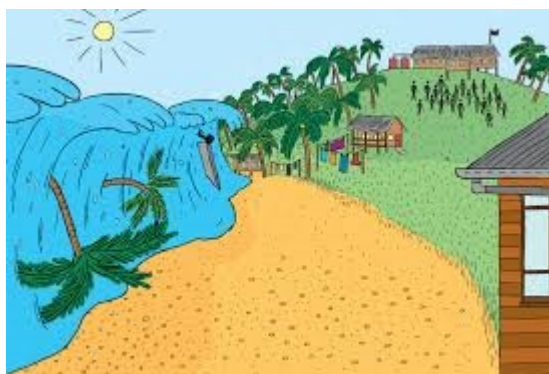




CLASS 3

This week, Class 3 have been learning all about natural disasters. We split into three big groups and have been researching facts about hurricanes, volcanoes or tsunamis. This has involved lots of computing skills such as navigating the internet to find facts that we are able to read and comprehend - not just copying whole chunks of text! We have also learnt how to snip and crop pictures, copy and paste key text and alter the size and font of writing.

Next week, we are visiting Shelterbox, a disaster relief charity based in Truro. We are all looking forward to learning more about what we can do to help people around the globe whose lives are affected by natural disasters.

Huge congratulations to the children of Class 4, who through a variety of games and well planned activities, managed to raise a majority of the total raised for Children In Need. We have added a few pictures to show you just some of the wonderful stalls on the day.

Class 4 sometimes find themselves with little windows of their own free time learning time. This week we spent it teaching one another something arithmetic based ie: division, adding fractions, finding percentages etc.

CHILDREN IN NEED 2019

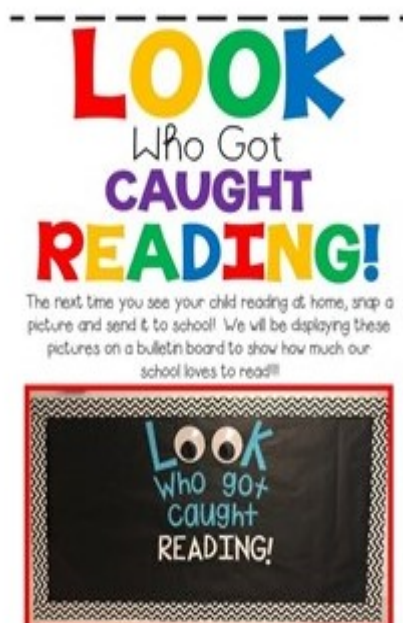
