

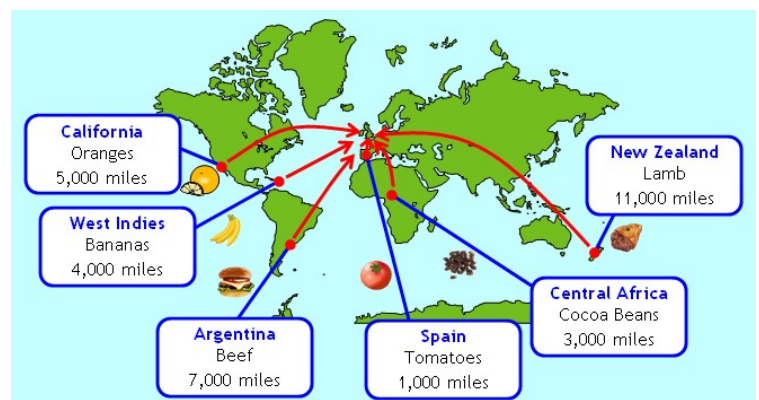
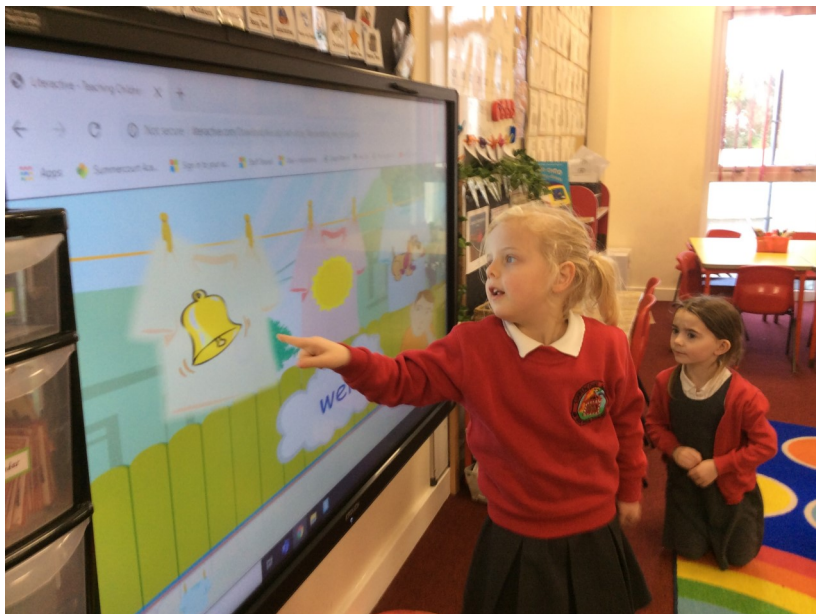
# Summerville Academy News

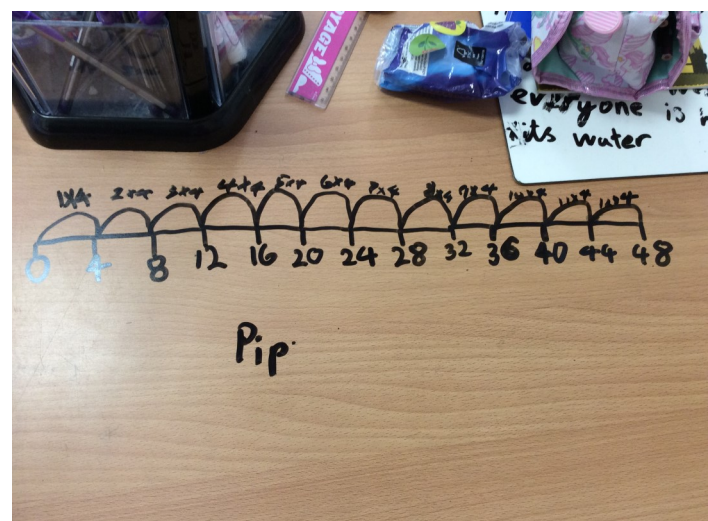


### CLASS 3

This week, Class 3 have been learning about the features included in a biography. After half term, we aim to write our own biographies about the great Martin Luther King.

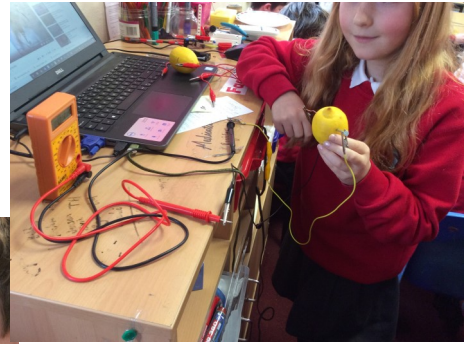
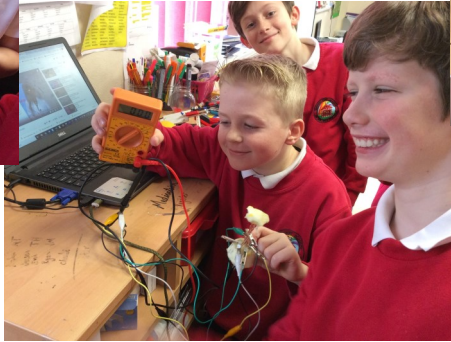
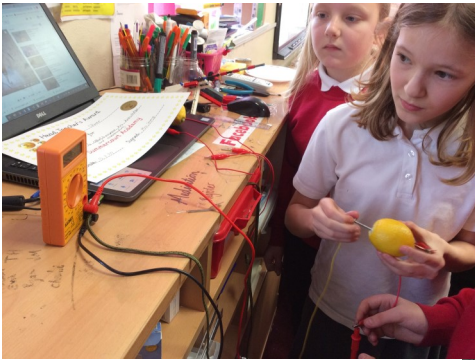
The Year 3 children have been learning about the relationship between the 2 and 4 time tables and spent some time representing the products in the 4 times table in a variety of different ways.

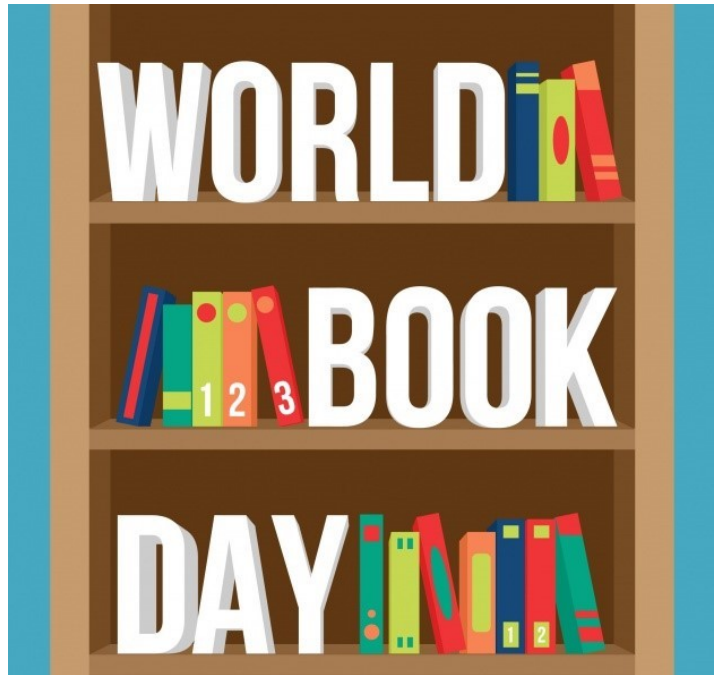


## **WORLD BOOK DAY**
