Summercourt Curriculum Approach

We wanted to share some new initiatives with you all that the teaching team and staff at Summercourt are currently focussed on implementing. We are extremely proud of the developments we have made to the Summercourt approach to the curriculum over the past two years and a half years. Our key inquiry question and project approach enable teachers to cover multiple curriculum subject areas and key learning knowledge within one project lesson.

An area that we have recognised we need to support our pupils with is understanding which subjects they are being taught during their project lessons and the cross curricular subject knowledge links in literacy also.

To support our pupils with being able to identify the specific subjects being taught we are implementing these strategies:

Vocabulary

- Think like a...(scientist/historian/geographer)
- What is a... (scientist/historian/geographer)

Gold subject boxes

 Items within the boxes to be worn, used, and referred to during science, history and geography lessons. (For example, teachers to wear a lab coat when teaching science)

Images displayed on the teaching whiteboard during lessons with key questions

What do you see? What do you think/know/infer? What do you wonder?

Please can I ask you all to support us with implementing and embedding these new strategies by reiterating/reinforcing them and discussing them with your child/children throughout the week at home.

We appreciate the support from our Summercourt community and the positive impact we can all have on the pupils by continuing to work as a strong team.
