CLASS 2

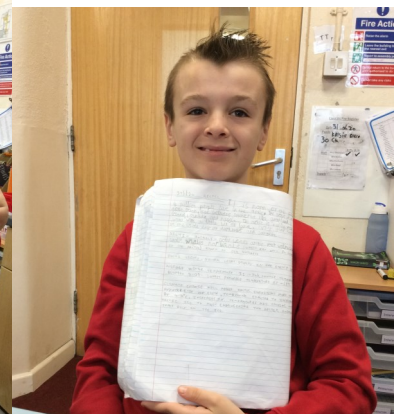
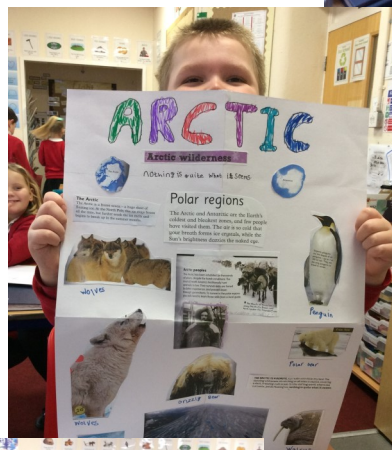
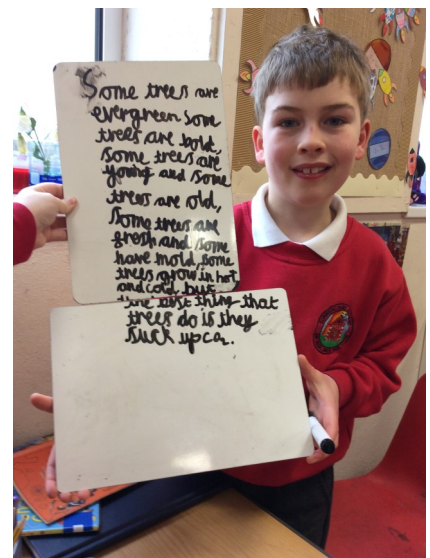
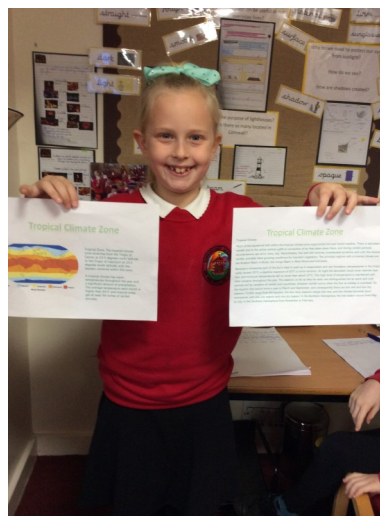

CLASS 3

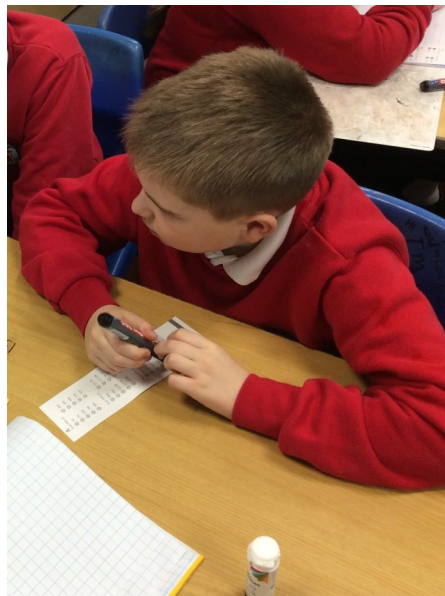

We have also learnt about deforestation in the Amazon rainforest and why it is happening.

Over the course of the week, some of us have been busy completing optional additional homework about climate zones. Edie created an arctic scene on a cake using fondant icing while Dexter chose to recreate a similar scene using cotton wool, paper and plastic animals. Ruan meanwhile wrote a fantastic poem about trees, and Monty and Shawn created fantastic, informative posters. Olivia, Josh and Charley researched facts and wrote them down on paper (including pictures!) What an amazing range of creative ways to showcase our learning!



CLASS 4

Class 4 have enjoyed a busy week. With a little guidance, the Y6 children have been teaching the Y5's how to find percentages of amounts. We have finished deconstructing and reconstructing our faces in the style of Picasso and cubism. And we have also been investigating and changing variables in the context of circuits and lightbulbs.

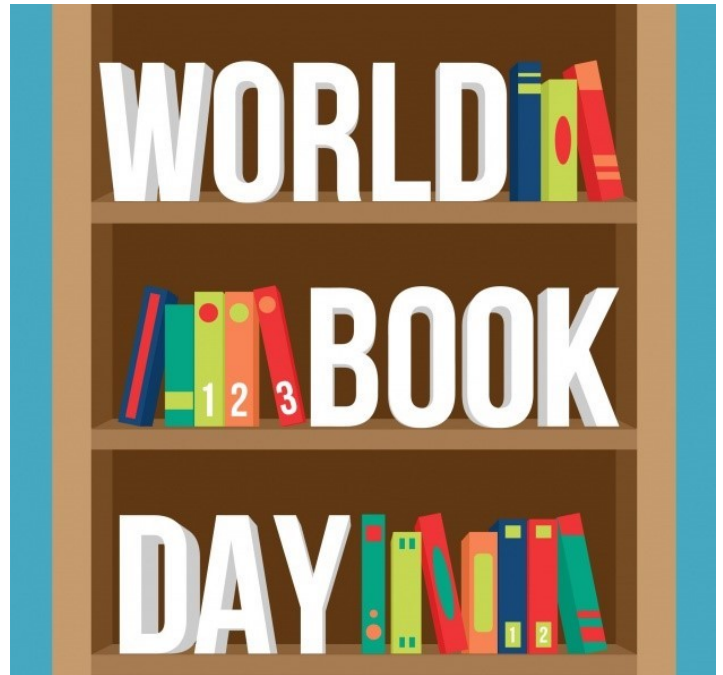
